## **CALL FOR ABSTRACT SUBMISSIONS**

**Abstract submissions are being accepted April 29 – June 17, 2019**. Abstracts addressing all public health topics are welcome and may be submitted for individual oral presentations, panel discussions, or posters.

*Please note that you do not need to be a member of OPHA to present at the conference. However, <u>all presenters must register for the conference</u>. No exceptions will be made.* 



## Submit abstracts for the following presentation formats:

**Individual Oral Presentation:** Oral presentations are 10-12 minutes in length. Three presentations, grouped by themes, will be presented in each session. Additional time will be allotted by a session moderator for Q&A and discussion.

**Poster:** Posters are visual presentations displayed on 8' x 4' bulletin boards. The poster session is scheduled for **Monday, October 14**.

**Panel Discussion:** A panel discussion (75-minute program session) includes a moderator and/or discussant and at least three panelists/presentations. Due to time constraints, only a limited number of panel discussions will be accepted. Submit: an overview abstract describing the overall purpose/theme of the panel and a minimum of **three** separate abstracts, one for each panelist. *NOTE: Panel submissions will only be considered if a summary abstract AND separate abstracts for each presentation are submitted*.

Abstracts will be peer reviewed and accepted based on selection criteria.
